PRACTICES RECOMMENDED

1. Try to hear Mass on week-days and receive Holy Communion.
2. Perform all your duties well and conscientiously. They are God's will for you, and when you do them to please Him they prove your love for Him and increase holiness in you. Renew this intention from time to time during the day.
3. Train yourself to recognise and accept God's will and arrangements concerning that happens to you, saying: "Thy will be done."
4. Make a short visit to our Divine Lord hidden in the Tabernacle—daily if possible.
5. Every Friday at least, make the Way of the Cross, etc., to keep your mind and heart in touch with the Passion of our Lord.
6. Be present at Benediction on Sunday evenings and as often as is convenient on week-days.
7. Say the Rosary with members of your family every evening to secure a special blessing on the home.
8. Read for at least a quarter of an hour from some spiritual book.
9. Make a quarter of an hour of Mental Prayer every day, if possible. This means talking in a personal way with God, Whom you love and by Whom you know you are loved.
10. Be a faithful member of your Sodality.
11. Say the prayers of this leaflet every day.

DAILY ACTS

In the Morning when you awake, say:—
In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.
Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I give you my heart and my soul.
O my God—I offer Thee all my thoughts, words and actions of this day—for Thy greater honour and glory—through Jesus Christ our Lord. I intend to gain all the Indulgences I can — and I place them in the hands of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
Say three "Hail Marys" in honour of the Immaculate Purity of Mary, and then: O Mary, by thy Immaculate Conception — make my body pure and my soul holy. O Mary, my Mother and my hope — I take refuge under thy mantle — there will I live and die — deliver me from sin — and grant me thy holy blessing.

OUR FATHER. HAIL MARY. CREDO.
During the Day—When you begin your work, say —
All for Thee, O my Lord! O my Jesus — All for Thee!
When you are tempted, say: Jesus and Mary, help me! or a "Hail Mary."

*When inclined to anger, say:—*O my Jesus, give me patience! My Mother Mary, restrain my tongue.
*When you have committed a fault, say:—*O my God, I am heartily sorry for all my sins — because they offend Thee, Who art infinitely good — and I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace — never to offend Thee again.
Before and after meals, make the sign of the cross and say grace.
*When you meet another, or, enter a house, say:—*God bless you, or, God bless all here, or, God bless the world.
At Night — Say the Family Rosary, your night prayers, examine your conscience, and make an act of Contrition. Say also three "Hail Marys" and the little prayers to Mary as in the morning.
*When in bed, fold your arms in the form of a cross, and say to yourself:—*I must die — I do not know when — not how — not where — but if I die in mortal sin — I am lost forever — O Jesus, have mercy on me!

ACT OF CONTRITION — as follows.
ACT OF FAITH — O my God, I believe in Thee and in all that Thou hast said through Thy holy Church, because Thy word is true.
ACT OF HOPE — O my God I hope in Thee for all my sins, because Thou art the merciful Father of all sinners, powerful, good and merciful, and because Thou art true to Thy word.
ACT OF CHARITY — O my God, I love Thee above all things because Thou art infinitely good, and for Thy sake I love my neighbour as myself.

Today is World Mission Sunday. Sometimes people think that missionaries are very special people,—that they are nuns or priests or a handful of very special lay people who have been picked out of the crowd by God to do amazing work in, "far away places with strange sounding names". Not true! Did you know that every baptized person is called to be a missionary wherever they happen to be. We are all called to be another Christ... every day. Just like Jesus himself, we are called to have a special care for the poor. That's why on mission Sunday we pray for those who work with the poorest of the poor - the churches front line people - around the world and we make a contribution to help them build schools and clinics, churches and parish halls, teacher training colleges and programmes that protect and care for children's spiritual and physical well being. It's what Jesus would have done. Thank you in advance for your prayers and generous support in spite of these very trying times. Together we are mission!

Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus,
I believe that you are present in the most Holy Sacrament.
I love you above all things, and I desire to receive you into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you.
