<p>TIDINESS appropriate placing of litter bins, absence of litter, advertising hoardings and indiscriminate dumping</p> <p>The village is completely litter free and clean. The derelict house beside Ryans should be demolished and this whole area needs to be landscaped.</p>	35	22 (31)
<p>PRESENTATION OF BUILDINGS shops, business premises, banks, factories, historic and public buildings, derelict sites and buildings, statues and monuments</p> <p>Most commercial premises are once again well presented, in particular Mullarkeys, Glynn's and Sheridans. O'Mannins, the Post Office and the CYMS Hall all need repainting. The forecourt of Ryans Welcome Inn looks extremely untidy. The Church and School look very well.</p>	35	24 (31)
<p>PRESENTATION OF NATURAL AMENITIES open spaces, village greens, river banks, foreshore, parks, trees</p> <p>A lot of effort has gone into the presentation of natural amenities and this is most encouraging. New flower beds, trees and shrubs all look extremely well. The banks of the river and the park are excellent. The tennis courts also look very well. When all the trees mature the village will look very nice.</p>	30	23 (26)
<p>APPEARANCE OF APPROACH ROADS verges, streets, back lanes and footpaths. Also car parks, seats, telephone kiosks, post boxes, litter bins, pumps and road signs</p> <p>Most approach roads looked quite well, however, closer attention could be paid to back roads and incidental spaces. If the Council cannot keep roads in proper trim it falls on the community to do so. The new stone walls throughout the village are excellent.</p>	40	22 (36)
<p>PRESENTATION OF RESIDENTIAL AREAS including open spaces</p> <p>Most houses are once again well presented, although a few window boxes along the main street would look very nice. Some new houses need to attend to the area between their boundary and the road.</p>	20	14 (18)
