# Milltown seeks support for playground revamp project

PLANS to upgrade Milltown's Community Playground were unveiled at an event in the Community Centre where the attendance were treated to a selection of entertainment from local children with dancing, singing and musical performances.

The event was to inform the public about the plans to renew the playground and to seek donations. The Playground recently secured funding under Measure 2 of CLAR funding and are seeking donations for the additional funds required to complete the project.

Cathal McHugh, who is spearheading the initiative said "We hope that families will give a donation of between €50 and €100 each. We know that there are demands of all sorts when it comes to family life and children, from school, to extracurricular activities like music, sport, dancing, etc but we see this as an investment in the community for your children, not just for one term or for one year but to use throughout their childhood."

The new playground will be enclosed with a fence and there will be new safety surfacing and a range of new equipment to cater for children between the ages of 3 and 14.

It will also include a new wheelchair accessible roundabout to help make the playground inclusive for all. Mr McHugh said it was very important to them that this project provide a new and modern facility to cater for children of all ages and abilities where people can come and meet and feel a sense of community.

"With that in mind we are hopeful people will see our vision and will literally buy into the project by putting their hand into their pocket," he added.

The event was attended by some past members of the Development Association who were instrumental in creating the original playground which is now part of an award-winning heritage park and river walk.
