MADAM,

I beg to intimate that you have been approved for enrolment in the Midwives Roll.

I send herewith (1) Certificate of Enrolment, (2) a Copy of the Rules, and (3) Form VIII. for Notification of Intention to Practise.

It is most important that you should forthwith fill up Form VIII. and send same to the Clerk of the Local Supervising Authority or the Medical Officer of Health of the district in which you practise or intend to practise.

The Local Supervising Authority is the Board of Health for Midwives practising in a county area and the County Borough Council for Midwives practising in a County Borough.

Certified Midwives, in their own interests, should immediately notify any change of name or address, giving their enrolment number, to the Local Supervising Authority of the District or Districts in which they practise, **and also to this Office.**

All Forms and Books which Certified Midwives are required to fill up and use are supplied free of charge by the Local Supervising Authorities, and when sending notifications of practice Midwives should make application for the books and forms which they require.
