On Thursday the 14th of March there will be a walking tour in Wellington to some of the key places that the Sons and Citizens of Eire frequented. More details nearer the time.

The Irish Ambassador Peter Ryan and the Minister of Agriculture, Damien O'Connor will officially launch the book. Damien as many of you know is also the MP for West Coast-Tasman – the region where my mother's side of the family come from – so he represents my NZ whakapapa.

You will all be invited to one of the events, but please understand that with the Thistle Inn we are limited by the capacity of the venue.

A special guest at all the functions will be Fr Eamon Aylward whom I have invited to come out from Ireland especially for the launch week. Fr Eamon has been a major contributor to the content of the book and he represents one of the main characters in the book – his uncle Maurice Leo Aylward. There are plans to take Eamon up to Opunake on Friday the 15th of March to see the grave of Maurice and meet some of the people from Taranaki. Once I have the final details I will update you again – probably early February.
