Answer: Padraic O'Droighneain (Patrick Thornton) of Clooniff

5. Name the man from Tooreeney townland, who died fighting in World War 1 in the Australian Army?

Answer: John McGrath

6. Name the man from Gortmore townland, who was in the Royal Navy, and died in 1917 and is buried in Moycullen Catholic Churchyard

Answer: Patrick Maloney.

7. State the surname of the two brothers from Moycullen who lived in Drimcong House who died in World Wars

Answer: Kilkelly

8. A father and son from Moycullen, who both died in World War 1 are commemorated in what church in Galway City?

Answer: St. Nicholas Collegiate Church

9. Name the man from Clooniff townland, who was in the American Merchant Navy, and died during World War 2

Answer: John O'Donohoe

10. Name the man from Cloonmore townland, who served with the United States Army, and was killed six weeks before the end of World War 1

Answer: James Keady.
