1. Name the landlord who built Knockbane School circa 1823?
Answer: Anthony O’Flaherty of Knockbane House.
2. What year was Tooreney school built? Was it 1877, 1887 or 1897?
Answer: Tooreney school was built in 1887 and is still in use today.
3. Name the Parish Priest that bequeathed €500 towards the first school which was built in Moycullen in 1834?
Answer: Fr Francis Xavier Blake
4. What year was Scoil Leamhchoill (Loughwell school) built? Was it 1872, 1882 or 1892?
Answer: 1872. It was replaced in 1958 by a new building which was closed in 1978.
5. What year was the Áras Uilinn Community Centre built as a primary school?
Answer: 1909
6. What year was Scoil Baile Nua (Newtown School) built?
Answer: 1900. It replaced the school built in Knockbane by local landlord Anthony O’Flaherty circa 1823.
7. What year was Tullokyne school built? Was it 1862, 1872 or 1882?
Answer: 1862
8. The late Miss Nell Greene finished her teaching career at Scoil Mhuire Moycullen, what school did she teach in before transferring to Scoil Mhuire?
Answer: Loughwell School
9. What year did the present Scoil Mhuire Moycullen open?
Answer: 1978
10. The late Sean Donnellan NT, who was Príomhoide in Loughwell and Tullokyne, served as member of Galway County Council in the 1950s. What party did he represent?
Answer: Fianna Fáil
