Description: What appeared to be a possible inland promontory fort (Casey 2005) proved on inspection in 2008 to be a naturally formed peninsula (dims. 49m N-S; 39m E-W), subtriangular in plan and irregular around its lake-side edges. A well-cut slightly curvilinear ditch-like feature (Wth 2.95; D 1.1m) separated the peninsula from the mainland. A wide spread of material excavated from the ditch formed a bank-like feature (Wth 6.45m; int. H 0.45m; ext. H 0.35m) on the exterior of the ditch. According to local information, the ditch was excavated in the 1960s-70s during land improvement works.

Description: In bogland. Aerial reconnaissance revealed several small circular unclassifiable earthen enclosures flanking the N bank of a stream (Casey 2005, 98, Fig. 20). The bank of the stream was field walked but nothing of archaeological significance was visible at ground level. The stream had been dredged and the resulting spoil was dumped along its N bank in linear sections and mounds. Turf banks were evident running upslope from the stream where the bog has been worked. It is possible that some of these features may have looked like enclosures from the air, however, nothing of archaeological significance is evident at ground level.
