Next Steps

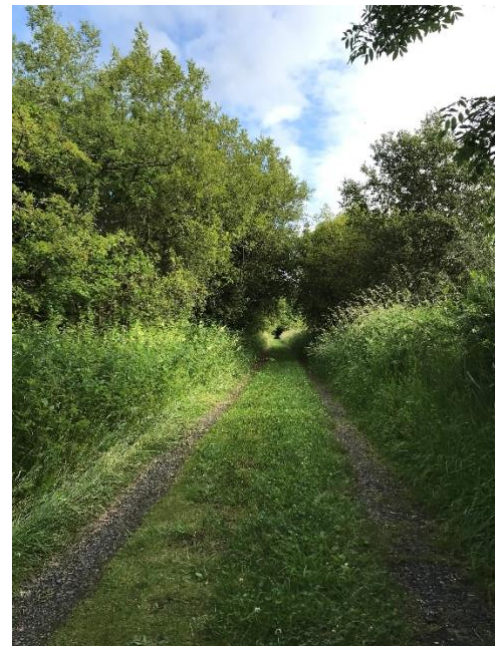
On foot of the successful completed audit, Marie Mannion, Heritage Officer at Galway County Council generously funded 'Reading your Local Landscape'.

This program provides a mentoring service, delivered by Zena Hocht Heritage Service, to help us kickstart some of the recommended actions of the Audit report. We are currently working on the development of a Digital StoryMap of the evolution of Dunmore from medieval times to present day, interpretive planning for the Bog Walk and research on the former National Schools in our area.
