FOREWORD

My family lived across the road from St. Patrick's cemetery and on fine summer evenings my mother would go across the road, lean on the wall and spend some time praying. She told us that it was very important to pray for the Holy Souls. A neighbour once remarked to her that she might be afraid of living so near to the cemetery. My mother said: "It is not the dead one needs to be afraid of but the living."

Mother told us that this cemetery, although it was in use as a cemetery then, that it originally was land given to the Workhouse Guardians by Lord Gort in order to bury the people who were dying in the Workhouse from cholera and dysentery together with other people in the Gort area who were dying during the famine. There have been burials in St. Patricks up to 1987, some of whom I knew, personally. She told us that each large stone in the cemetery was a grave marker. At that time, 1959, there were no headstones there. Since then, a few headstones have been erected.

Each year, in the month of November, the priest who said the 11a.m. Mass in Gort would walk out to the cemetery and offer prayers for the dead and bless the cemetery. Family members of those buried in St. Patrick's and neighbours would attend.

The people who grazed the cemetery removed the animals for the month of November, as does Padraic Lally who grazes it at present.

In recent years, when the cemetery Masses take place during the summer months St. Patrick's is being omitted. I feel that it is so sad that the hundreds of people who died horrible deaths from famine and illnesses caused by famine who are buried in St. Patrick's are being forgotten.

My hope is that this project will help to keep those people's memory alive.

I am very pleased that the people who are buried in St. Patrick's are now to have a memorial plaque erected in their memory and a book of remembrance placed in St. Colman's Church, Gort.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Poor Law System was introduced in Ireland in 1838. Gort Poor Law Union was formally declared a Poor Law Union on the 20th August 1839. (1) The area covered 140 square miles – 224 square kilometres.

The Gort Union comprised the barony of Kiltartan, the southern part of Dunkellin, the south-west part of Loughrea and Kilkeedy which was a small part of the barony of Inchiquin, Co. Clare and adjacent to the south and west of the barony of Kiltartan.

The Gort Union consisted of ten electoral divisions, each of which was represented by members of the Board of Guardians, as follows:-
Ardrahan (2), Beagh (2), Kilbeacanty (2), Kilkeedy (1), Killeenavarra (2), Killeeneen (2), Kilmacduagh (2), Kiltartan (1), Kiltomas (1) and Kinvara (3).

The Union was overseen by a Board of Guardians, 18 in number plus 6 executive Guardians, making a total of 24. After 1847 half the members of each board held office ex-officio – local magistrates, for example – and the other half were elected. Prior to the 1880s most board members were local landlords, businessmen and substantial farmers.

Each Union contained a centrally located workhouse built to a standard design. While the Poor Law Guardians were legally responsible for the management of the workhouse, the day-to-day running of the building was carried out by a number of salaried officials. The clerk and treasurer of the Union operated the administrative system of the Poor Law. In terms of management of the workhouse the most important figure was the master. Very often the master's wife acted as matron. The dispensary doctor ran the dispensary system. Outdoor relief was overseen by the relieving officer. (2)

THE GORT WORKHOUSE

The Gort Workhouse was erected during the years 1840 and 1841 on a seven-acre site in the townland of Rindifin. It was designed by George Wilkinson to accommodate 500 inmates. It was officially opened on 11th December 1841.

In September 1844, the Board requested a fifty-bed hospital but no funding was available and they were unable to get a loan. A temporary shed was erected to accommodate 100 patients. (3)

The motion to build a 50-bed hospital was defeated on the grounds that the Board did not "consider it expedient to incur the expense of erecting a fever hospital." This proved to be an unfortunate decision and one which made the Medical Officer's life more difficult in the ensuing years. The number of deaths which were caused by the Gort Union's lack of preparation for the subsequent influx of fever patients is incalculable.

Conditions continued to worsen in the workhouse. The Guardians were huddling the patients together, side by side with the other poor.

Potato blight was first noticed in the late autumn of 1845 and as the potato was the staple diet of most people this led to disastrous results. (4)

In February 1847 the Union's Medical Officer, Dr. Martin Daly Nolan, complained that patients were lying in filth and dirt, adding "in fact, the whole house is one mass of disease and infection. It would be safer and more charitable to close the house."

By the summer of 1847 fever and dysentery were raging in Gort. The matron, Mrs. Tully, lost her life in the discharge of her duties and the master contracted fever. The only paid nurse received a paltry four pounds a year. There were stories of the Guardians sending fever-stricken persons off their own estates with tickets of admission to the workhouse, and of those victims being placed alongside people who were still free of the infection. Terrified inmates then fled the workhouse, carrying fever to all parts of the Union. By June, 1847, there were three in every bed. Rain came down in torrents in the fever sheds. Patients had only one blanket in December and many of the children had to stay in bed for want of clothing. (5)

An English clergyman conducted a tour of Irish workhouses. In Gort he was

shocked by the sight of 450 women being fed in the hall. The large number had to be fed in relays. Some had to wait until midnight for dinner. The scheme was a "complete shambles." The men bringing in the food had short, thick sticks which they used very freely and brutally to protect the tins of stirabout from the rush made for them by these hungry women. Open sewers ran from the workhouse and close to the infirmary was a very large heap of manure. (6)

THE FEVER HOSPITAL

Dr. Nolan's lengthy battle for suitable accommodation for fever patients makes chilling reading.

Outside of the workhouse, accounts from the electoral divisions also highlight the miserable conditions. For example, in a begging letter in March 1847 to the Central Relief Committee of the Society of Friends (The Quakers), Fr. Patrick B. Quin, (sic) P.P. Ardahan gives the following statistics:

Deaths from 1st October 1846 to 1st April 1847: 61

Deaths known to be caused by famine: 37

Six of the above 37 died of starvation and thirty-one died from fever and dysentery brought on for want of nourishment. Sixteen people died in the same period last year. Fr. Quin continued: "I am half my time all but mad by the state of my poor parishioners and my Curate in fever. The population of the parish is 3,200. May God bless them; my heart is broken at the scenes about me. If we had our own parliament this would not be so."

Fr. Quin died in August 1847 of fever caught in the discharge of his duties. He was 57 years of age. (7)

The Gort workhouse, in common with many other workhouses, experienced a change of management in February 1848. Two Vice-Guardians, Messrs. Hall and Dunne had the unenviable task of trying to cope with worsening conditions as the Great Famine ravaged the countryside.

As yet there was no fever hospital. The Vice-Guardians provided extra accommodation by the following means -

THE ERECTION OF FEVER SHEDS

Auxiliary Workhouse for young girls at Bridge House (present Convent of Mercy)
 Auxiliary Workhouse for young boys at Lawn House, Church St. (now demolished)
 Cholera Hospital at River House, Cannahowna
 Auxiliary Workhouse and Hospital in Kinvara. (8)
 Plans went ahead for a permanent fever hospital on grounds adjacent to the
 workhouse.

The hospital was opened in April 1848.

Three acres in the townland of Lavalley, about half a mile from the town were procured from the landlord, Lord Gort for a cemetery. "The numerous internments in the confined grounds about the house, which we are now having covered with additional earth, are quite enough to create contagion and would be fearful in warm weather. Not more than 18 inches of clay is used to cover the coffins. "

John Hynes and Thomas Williams were contracted to build the cemetery wall in April 1848. The cost was 15 shillings per perch. According to local tradition, there is a deep trench at the end furthest from the gate on the main road where the people who died in the workhouse were buried.

From 24th June 1848 to 18th May 1850, the number of deaths was 367. During that time, from early Spring to mid-Summer 1849, cholera raged. In the week ending 7th April 1849 there were 242 cases and 89 deaths. The following week 101 people died as a direct result of cholera. (11)

Most, if not all, were buried in St. Patrick's Cemetery.

MAINTENANCE

Landlords were liable for paying all rates on property valued at under four pounds, the tenant being exempt. That is why many landlords did not care for poor tenants and were liable to evict them. The rates were used for the upkeep of the workhouse.

Average weekly cost of a pauper in Gort Workhouse:

1844: two shillings

1845: one shilling and nine pence

1846: one shilling and 10 pence

1847: two shillings and four pence

This diet comes from the date 11th August 1848. It had improved since 1846 and 1847, possibly because of the appointment of paid Vice-Guardians in February.

By November 1846 the Board of Guardians were in financial trouble: "No provisions, no fuel, no clothes, no person would contract to supply them" because there was no money from the rates to pay them. Thereafter, during the Famine, the Board was strapped for cash. The staff were often left waiting for their wages for considerable periods of time. In October 1848 the Guardians levied a rate of five shillings on the entire Union. This was a big jump from January of the previous year when the rates varied from 5 pence in some electoral divisions to 2 shillings in others.

EMIGRATION

Various references to emigration occur in the Minutes of the Gort Union, e.g. "In the electoral division of Kiltartan assistance was given to defray emigration expenses to the USA for Margaret Connell: One pound seven shillings and ten pence; John Cusack: twelve shillings." (12)

"We advert to the wives and families of persons who emigrate to America. These, on the departure of the head of the family, apply for relief. We believe that the husband usually disposes of everything he has, in order to supply sufficient funds to defray the expense of the voyage. In some instances, we have reason to believe that the landlord, on condition of getting possession of the land of a tenant, has advanced the amount necessary to enable the head of the family to proceed to America and after his departure the rest of the family apply for relief. Emigration of this kind will be very general during Spring. When funds are remitted to take a portion of the family over, in general, those only who are grown, healthy and able to work, are sent out, whilst the young and helpless children are still left dependent on the poor rates." (13)

The best documented event in the history of emigration from the Gort Workhouse occurred by means of what is known as the Earl Grey scheme. Sixteen orphan girls, in their late teens were selected in late 1849 to be sent to Australia on the ship Thomas Arbuthnot. They and girls from other workhouses in the west of Ireland arrived safely in Sydney in June 1850. (14) In fact, some of their descendants have visited South Galway, searching for their roots.

In August 1854, 104 girls from Gort workhouse were sent to Quebec on the Mary Carson. Thirty-five of that number went to New York to relatives and friends after disembarking in Quebec. So far, we have been unable to trace their subsequent history. (15)

Lord Gort was generally regarded as a benevolent landlord but he was forced to sell his Lough Cutra estate in 1851 due to falling rents and his kind exertions during the famine. His tenants were not so fortunate immediately after the famine:

"On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 440 individuals were evicted in the neighbourhood of Gort by recent purchasers in the Encumbered Estates Court. They resided on the estate of which Viscount Gort was the former owner. His

successor (Vicessimus Knox) has not copied his Lordship's moderation." (16)

Before William Gregory sold off parts of his estate, he took care to see that his long-standing and trusted tenants had renewed their leases so that they would be legally protected against eviction by the new owners. (17)
